Begins with a fresh easterly breeze under Double Reef
Sail &c. Mr. boat fastened to a whale at 1 P.M. took him
alongside at 2. Commenced heaving him in neck & heels
at 4 P.M. finished. Mr. part fresh & together by breeze &
squally. L. part ditto under Double Reef. S. Sail
&c. & M. Sail &c.

Sunday 15th

Begins with a strong breeze & cloudy under Short Sail
Mr. part pleasant. L. part light breeze & cloudy under
all sail boiled the blubber of whale

Sunday 16th

Begins with a light easterly breeze
under Short Sail. Mr. part pleasant. L. part cloudy & a mod-
erate breeze under Short Sail at 8 P.M. commenced
stowing our oil &c.

Tuesday 17th

Begins pleasant with a light breeze at 3 P.M. took
the whale alongside at 4. Commenced cutting in
at 5. Cut in 4 whales. Mr. part squally. L. part fresh
breeze at 6 P.M. cut in the other whale &c.
squally & raining the remainder of the day.

Wednesday Sept. 18th 1844

Begins & ends pleasant with a light easterly breeze
all hands employed in boiling &c. saw one seal.

Lat. by Obs. 35° 20' N. Long. by Chr. 47° 10' W.

Thursday 19th

Begins pleasant with a fine easterly breeze under
all sail. Crew employed in boiling Mr. part pleasant
at 12 a clock finished boiling L. part squally & raining
under Double Reef. S. Sail &c.

Lat. by Obs. 35° 33' N. Long. by Chr. 46° 57' W.

Friday 20th

Begins squally with a strong westerly breeze under
Short Sail. Mr. part light breeze. L. part cloudy & a mod-
erate breeze under Short Sail at 8 P.M. commenced
stowing our oil &c.

Lat. by Obs. 35° 10' N. Long. by Chr. 47° 10' W.

Saturday 21st

Begins with a moderate breeze & clouds at 4 P.M.
finished stowing 4 Bbls. In P.M. & L. part cloudy
& almost calm
