

Remarks on Thursday June 25th 1835
Commences with fresh breezes at S.E.W.
Ship heading S.E. Burnett in company middle
and latter part wind and weather the
same this concludes Lat. 42° 10' N.
Long 37° 05' W.

Remarks on Friday June 26th 1835
First part fine weather weather spoke with
B. Burnett middle and latter part fresh breezes
at S.W. by E. Ship heading S.E. by E. this ends
Lat in 41° 40' N.
Long in 37° 13' W.

Remarks on Saturday June 27th 1835
Commences with fresh breezes at S.E.W.
Ship heading S.E. middle and latter part
the same this concludes Lat. in 41° 05'
B. Burnett in sight Long in 31° 35'

Remarks on Sunday June 28th 1835
these 24 hours fresh breezes and squally
wind from S.W. to W.S.W. Ship heading
to the S.E. sighted a ship heading to the west
another S.E. this concludes B.B. midnight
Lat. & det. 40° 15'
Long in 29° 20'

Remarks on Monday June 29th 1835
Commences with strong breezes at S.W.
to W.S.W. Ship heading S.E. and latter
middle part squally latter part the same
Spoke ship James of N Bedford with 60 lbs
this ends Lat in 39° 25'
Long in 28° 20'

Remarks on Tuesday June 30th 1835
first part moderate breezes at N.E. by E.
Ship heading S.E. at 3 P.M. sighted Graciosa
bearing E.S.E. also sighted St. George and 4 sail
in sight latter part light airs and calm
Graciosa bearing N.W. Dist 6 miles

Remarks on Wednesday July 1st 1835
Commences with light breezes and calm
at 1 P.M. a fish boat came along side
middle and latter part calm sighted
a ship sailing this ends Graciosa bearing
N.W. Dist 40 miles

Transactions on Thursday July 2nd 1835
Commences with fine weather wind South
middle and latter part squally wind South
sighted 3 sail this ends Graciosa bearing
S.E. Dist 10 miles

Transactions on Friday July the 3rd
Commences with fresh breezes at S.W. and
squally at 2 P.M. spoke ship Beres of N Bedford
32 days out no whales middle and latter
part squally this ends saw no whales
Graciosa bearing South. Dist 6 miles

Transactions on Saturday July the 4th 1835
Commences with fine weather went on
shore at Graciosa with one boat and got
some potatoes onions &c for one barrel
blacfish oil latter part fine weather
Tiersara bearing S.W. Dist 8 miles 2 ships
in sight this ends

Remarks on Sunday July the 5th 1835
first part light breezes and fine weather
cruising of Tiersara latter part light
breezes at S.W. 2 sail in sight
this ends

Remarks on Monday July the 6th 1835
Commences with light breezes and calm at
7 P.M. spoke B ship Burnett and ship
Cicero of N Bedford all well no oil
latter part fine weather saw no whales
2 sail in sight Tiersara bearing S.W.
Dist 10 miles
