

Sunday Sept. 13th 1835
These 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. Ship heading S.E. Lighted no whales at 9 A.M. passed the Barque Ship Royal. Williams of St. Andrews N. B. sunnuck the Lucas in sight and Gald Hunter Do. thus Ends Lat. in 2.50 N. Long in 11.15 W.

Monday Sept. 14th 1835
These 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E.W. Ship heading S.E. at 5 A.M. tacked Ship and heading West by Compass passed a Ship heading S.E. Lucas and B. Ship and Brig in sight thus Ends Employed in setting back the rigging Lat. in 2.18 N. Long in 10.20 W.

Tuesday Sept. 15th 1835
These 24 Light breezes at S.E.W. Ship heading West at 2 A.M. tacked and headed S.E. at 7 tacked and heading W. by S. thus Ends Lucas in sight Lat. in 1.52 N. Long in 11.00 W.

Thursday Sept. 16th
These 24 hours brisk breezes at S.W. and S.E.W. Ship heading West and W. by S. Lighted no whales thus Ends Lucas in sight Lat. in 1.14 N. Long in 12.00 W.

Thursday Sept. 17 1835

These 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. & South Ship heading by the wind S.W. by W. Lighted no whales thus Ends Employed in coopers provisions &c Lucas in sight Lat. in 00.50 N. Long in 13.00 W.

Friday Sept. 18 1835

First part wind S.E. Ship heading S.W. by Compass latter part the same Lighted finbacks Employed in coopers provisions thus concludes Lucas in sight Lat. in 1.45 N. Long in 14.25 W.

Saturday Sept. 19 1835

These 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. Ship heading S.W. by Compass Lighted no whales thus Ends Lucas in sight Lat. in 3.35 N. Long in 15.30 W.

Sunday Sept. 20 1835

These 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. Ship heading S.W. under all sail Lighted no whales but Ship Lucas in sight Lat. in 5.32 South Long in 17.00 W.

Monday Sept. 21 1835

These 24 hours fresh breezes at S.E. Ship heading S.W. by Compass Lighted no whales thus Ends Lucas in sight Lat. in 7.27 Long in 18.30
