First part moderate breeze at  
W.N.W. sighted one right whale going  
quick to windward did not lower  
later part sighted nothing but finbacks  
thus ends Lucas in sight

Tuesday Nov. 24

These 24 hours fine weather first  
part saw no right whales later part  
saw whales took one thus ends  
saw the Lucas take one thus ends  
Lat. in 40° 18' Long 20° 20'

Wednesday Nov. 25

First part moderate breeze at the  
North cut in the whale and lowered  
for other whales but did not fasten  
later part strong gales sighted the  
Lucas cutting thus ends employed  
in boiling Lat. in 40° 40'  
Long in 20° 40'

Thursday Nov. 26

Strong gales with rain cooled down  
later part thick fog employed in  
boiling at 4 P.M. wore ship and  
headed to the N.N.E. sighted the  
Lucas at 11 P.M. No acc. of acc. 48  
thus ends Long in 21° 00'

Friday Nov. 27

First part strong breeze at N.N.E.  
ship heading N.E. middle part foggy  
later part saw 2 whales lowered did  
not fasten employed in flensing  
down oil thus ends Lat. 40° 40'  
Long in 20° 00'

Saturday Nov. 28

First part strong breeze at N.W. P.  
ship heading to the westward  
middle part rainy later part  
wind south and blowing heavy  
sighted nothing thus ends

Long 20° 40'
