Commences with moderate breezes at the N.E. Ship heading South at 2 P.M. Spoke Ship Lucas with 9 whales Middle and latter part Strong Gale at west N.W. Ship heading North after 7 A.M.; at 9 Saw a whale lowered did not fasten

Tuesday Dec. 8 1835

First part Strong Gale at the N.E. Ship heading North under Short Sail Latter part moderate wind at west Steering North. Thus Ends Lucas in Sight

Wednesday Dec. 9th

Commences with moderate breezes at the westward Ship heading to the North Sighted nothing Thus Ends Employed in repairing Mizen topsail Lucas in Sight

Thursday Dec. 10

First part light breezes at the N.E. at 3 P.M. Sighted a whale lowered at 5 took it to the Ship at 9 finished cutting Latter part fresh breezes at W.N.W. Ship heading to the North Employed in boiling Lucas in Sight

Friday Dec. 11 1835

First part Strong breezes at the west Ship heading to the North Latter part moderate wind at N.W. at 10 A.M. Sighted a whale lowered and sent the Tonne Thus Ends Lucas in Sight with a whale Long Side

Saturday Dec. 12

First part Light breezes at N.E. Sighted no whales Latter part moderate breezes at the S.W. Ship heading N.E. Employed in stowing away oil Thus Concludes Lucas in Sight boiling

Sunday Dec. 13

First part fine weather at 2 P.M. Sighted a whale lowered at 3.30 took the whale to the Ship and cut her in Latter part fresh breezes at N.E. at 8 P.M. Sighted a Shal Spinn whales lowered and took 2 at 11.30 to the Ship Thus Ends Sighted Lucas Cutting Thus Ends

Monday Dec. 14

These 24 hours Strong Gale Employed in boiling at 3 P.M. cut in one of the whales Latter part too rough to cut Thus Ends
