first part strong breezes and regid
at 3 P.M. hooked on the other whale
and cut her in latter part moderate
sighted no whales Employed in hauling
sighted the Lucas whaling thus End
Lat. in 38.00
Long 17.50

Wednesday Dec. 16. 1835

first part fine weather sighted right
whales and chased but did not fasten
~~whales~~ chasing sighted a school
Sperm whales and took 2 to the Ship
at 9 P.M. latter part fine weather
Employed in cutting sighted Lucas cutting
thus End Lat. 38.10
Long 18.00

Thursday Dec. 17

these 24 hours fine weather wind
N.E.W. at 6 P.M. finished cutting the
whales latter part sighted right whales
Lawend did not fasten spoke Lucas
she had taken 4 Sperm whales all
hands Employed in hauling blowing
away oil &c Lat. in 38.22
Long in 18.00

Friday Dec. 18

these 24 hours moderate breezes from
the North. at 4 P.M. killed the whale
took in head &c at 7 P.M. latter part took
in the body thus End all hands Employed
Lucas in sight Lat. in 38.00
Long in 17.40

Saturday Dec. 19

these 24 hours Commences with strong
breezes with rain latter part moderate
Employed in hauling hauling down oil
&c thus End Lat. in 37.58
Long in 17.20

Sunday Dec. 20

first part fine weather latter part
the same sighted whales Lawend did
not fasten saw the Lucas take a whale
Employed in hauling away oil
thus End finished hauling at 11 P.M.
Lat in 37.30
Long in 17.30

Monday Dec. 21

first part fine weather sighted ^{whales} Lawend
thrust and killed 2 one took
the other took to the Ship at P.M.
latter part fine weather cut the whale
&c sighted Lucas and another ship
thus End Lat. in 37.48
Long in 17.40

Tuesday Dec. 22

first part fine weather spoke Ship
Liverpool 900 barrels 200 of which
was Sperm latter part much sighted
no whales the 2 ships in sight
thus End Employed in hauling
blowing away oil thus End
Lat. in 38.00
Long in 17.55
