whales Employed in various work

Tuesday Feb. 16th 1836
All these 24 hours fine weather
and fresh breeze Ship heading N.E.
under all sail Lighted no whales
Employed in ship duty Lucas in sight
Lat. in 23.45
Long in 6.20

Wednesday Feb. 17th
These 24 hours light breeze at
P.S.P. Lighted nothing Employed
in painting ship Lucas in sight

Thursday Feb. 18th 1836

day before Lighted nothing thus

Lighted 2 ships at 11 spoke ship
Herald of Fairhaven 600 barrels
