Long in 20.15 W.

Wednesday March 9 1836

These 24 hours fine weather and gentle breeze
at S.E. Ship heading S.W. at 8 A.M.
Spoke Ship Elizabeth of London bound to
New Zealand whaling this Ends
Lat. in 8.00
Long in 21.50

Thursday March 10 1836

All these 24 hours brisk breeze and fine
weather Ship heading S.W. at 5 P.M. Spoke
British Barque Abingham from London Sighted
Several Sail this Ends Employed in various
Jobs Lucas in Sight Lat. in 6.53 Long 24.00
