heading S.W. thus Ends Lucas in company

Sunday March 13th 1836

These 24 hours brisk breezes and fair
weather Ship heading N.W. Employed
in little or nothing thus Ends
Lucas in sight

Lat. in $3^{\circ} 10'$
Long. in $30^{\circ} 40'$

Monday March 14th 1836

These 24 hours Squally with heavy
showers of rain Ship heading N.W.
Sighted nothing thus Ends Lucas in sight

Lat. in $1^{\circ} 54'$
Long. in $31^{\circ} 40'$

Tuesday March 15 1836

These 24 hours fresh breezes and squally
Sighted a Brig Steaming North first part
heading N.W. latter part N.W. by N. Sighted
no whales thus Ends Lucas in sight

Lat. in $10^{\circ} 12'$
Long. in $33^{\circ} 30'$

Wednesday March 16 1836

These 24 hours wind from N.E. to
S.E. and Squally Ship heading S.W. by W.
Sighted no whales Lucas in sight

Lat. in $11^{\circ} 22'$
Long. in $34^{\circ} 30'$

Thursday March 17 1836

These 24 hours fine and brisk breezes
at E.N.E. Ship heading N.W. by W. Sighted
no whales thus Ends Lucas in sight

Lat. $3^{\circ} 34' N.$
Long. $36^{\circ} 00'$

Friday March 18th 1836

These 24 hours light breezes and passing
showers of rain Ship heading N.W. by W. Sighted
nothing Lucas in sight

Lat. in $6^{\circ} 00' N.$
Long. in $37^{\circ} 00'$

Saturday March 19 1836

These 24 hours light and variable
winds Sighted nothing this day but Ship
Lucas

Lat. in $6^{\circ} 03' N.$
Long. in $38^{\circ} 00' W.$

Sunday March 20 1836

These 24 hours commences with light
breezes at the E.N.E. Ship heading N.W. by W.
latter part brisk breezes and fine weather
Sighted nothing but Ship Lucas

Lat. in $7^{\circ} 29'$
Long. in $39^{\circ} 50'$
