51 Saturday Sept. 30th Commences with moderate breezes at S.E. Ship heading S.E. by S. sighted a Barque Ship Steering N.W. with Ship'sail Steering Sails and a moon's tail set middle and latter part Brisk breeze at S.E. by S. Ship heading S.W. by S. sighted nothing thus concludes Lat. in 8.17 S. Long by Chron. 17.00

52 Sunday October 1st All these 24 hours Brisk breezes at S.E. Ship heading S.E. by S. latter part saw a Ship Steering N.W. thus concludes Lat. in 10.44 S. Long in 17.50

53 Monday October 2nd All these 24 hours Brisk breezes at S.E. by S. Ship heading S.W. by S. sighted nothing thus ends Employed in painting boats &c Lat. in 13.11 S. Long in 18.30 W.

54 Tuesday Oct. 3rd All these 24 hours moderate breezes at S.E. by S. Ship heading S.W. by S. all hands Employed in various jobs thus concludes Lat. in 15.24 S. Long in 19.20 W.

55 Wednesday Oct. 4th Commences with light breezes at S.E. by S. Ship heading S.W. by S. middle and latter part equally light nothing thus concludes Lat. in 17.25 S. Long in 20.20 W.

56 Thursday Oct. 5th These 24 hours moderate breezes at the S.E. Ship heading S.E. by S. under all sail Employed in various jobs thus ends Lat. in 19.40 S. Long in 21.30 W.

61 Tuesday Oct. 11th Commences with strong breezes at the S.W. Ship heading South at 6 P.M. left by heading W. by S. under close reef M. topsail & Main spencer Middle and latter part strong gales at West sighted nothing thus concludes Lat. in 31.30 S. Long in 20.20 W.

62 Wednesday Oct. 11th Commences with strong gales at S.W. by S. Ship heading South under Main topsail & spencers middle the same latter part light winds at S.W. sighted finbacks Employed in repairing fore topsail thus ends Lat. in 31.50 S. Long in 19.30 W.
