72 Saturday
Oct. 21st 1837 Commences with moderate breezes at the
North Ship heading S. W. sighted Thompson's
and finbacks middle part fresh breezes with
rain later part strong gales at N. N. W. Ship
heading west at 9 A.M. the Cooper fell
overboard hove a rope and he caught
it hauled him on board without any
harm thus ends Lat. by Oct. 37° 45'

73 Sunday
Oct. 22nd Commences with strong gales at N. N. W.
Ship heading west middle part more moderate
breezes at S. W. later part very strong gales with
a heavy sea running took in water boat thus
ends Lat. in 38° 35'
Long. in 17° 30'

74 Monday
Oct. 23 Commences with strong gales at the W. N. W.
Ship heading S. W. later part the same sent
down fore top of the mast sighted nothing thus
ends Lat. 39° 02'
Long. 17° 00'
