First part light Sails and Calm
Sighted no whales later part Saw
Several Chased at noon got fast
to a cow whale and calf thus
Concludes Lat. in $34^{\circ} 17'$
Long in $14^{\circ} 00'$

121 Saturday
Dec. 9

All these 24 hours fine weather
at 1.30 P.M. took the whales to
the Ship at 7 finished cutting
later part Chasing at 11 A.M. got
fast to whales at noon Sighted
whale Spouting Cloud thus Ends
Lat. $34^{\circ} 40'$
Long $14^{\circ} 00'$

122 Sunday
Dec. 10th
1837

All these 24 hours light breezes
and fine weather at 1.30 P.M. took
the whale to the Ship & cut it in
and commenced boiling at 9
A.M. Saw a whale Landed did not
fasten thus Ends Employed in
boiling Lat. $34^{\circ} 55'$
Long $13^{\circ} 40'$

123 Monday
Dec. 11

All these 24 hours light breezes
and calm at 6 P.M. Saw two
right whales Landed did not
fasten later part Saw no right whales
thus Ends Employed in boiling
Saw 2 Ship Stowing Oil
Lat. $34^{\circ} 45'$
Long $13^{\circ} 50'$

124 Tuesday
Dec. 12

All these 24 hours fine weather at
5.30 P.M. Sighted a School of Spinn
whales 2 1/2 miles off Landed at 8 took
2 to the Ship later part Employed
in cutting Saw two R. whales Landed
did not fasten thus Concludes
Lat. in $34^{\circ} 40'$
Long in $13^{\circ} 50'$

125 Wednesday
Dec. 13

all these these 24 hours light
breezes and calm Saw no whales
Employed in boiling and Stowing
down oil thus Concludes
Lat. in $34^{\circ} 38'$
Long in $14^{\circ} 00'$

126 Thursday
Dec. 14

First calm Saw nothing later
part moderate breezes at 11
with Showers of rain Saw a
whale Landed did not fasten
thus Ends Employed in boiling
Lat. in $34^{\circ} 33'$
Long in $14^{\circ} 10'$

127 Friday
Dec. 15

Commenced with moderate breezes
from N.W. at 3 P.M. Saw whales Landed
did not get fast later part fresh breezes
Saw nothing at 7 A.M. finished boiling
Employed in Stowing down
Lat. $34^{\circ} 19'$
Long $14^{\circ} 20'$

128 Saturday
Dec. 16

Commenced with fresh breezes at 10.
Employed in Stowing away oil at
7 P.M. Spoke with with an American
Ship from Boston did not learn
her name nor where bound middle
part strong breezes at 10 later
part moderate at 8 A.M. Saw whale
to windward Landed at noon took
a whale to the Ship thus Ends
Lat. in $34^{\circ} 08'$
Long in $15^{\circ} 00'$
