squally saw nothing thus concludes  
Lat. 40.24

Friday  
March 16 Commences with fresh  
breezes at the South at 6 P.M.  
Spoke Ship Condor New Bedford  
1000 barrels oil Latter part fresh  
breezes from P.S.W. saw no whales  
thus concludes Condor in company  
Lat. in 40.00  
Long. in 54.30

Saturday  
March 17 Commences with fresh breezes  
at the South Middle part the  
same Latter part moderate saw  
no whales thus ends Lat. 41.14  
Condor in sight Long. 53.30

Sunday  
March 18 Commences with light breezes at
