Wednesday
April 4 Commenced with fine weather
Saw a whale and chased did not
faster. Latter part fresh breezes
Saw nothing thus Ends
49 fathoms water Lat 41.06

Thursday
April 5 Commenced with fresh breezes
at the N.W. Saw nothing
middle part squally. Latter
part fresh breezes. Saw one
Sail thus Ends 50 fathoms water
Lat. 41.04

Friday
April 6 Commenced with fresh breezes at
west. Saw nothing. Latter part
the same. at noon sounded found
no bottom Lat. 41.05

Saturday
April 7 Commenced with fresh breezes
at the westward. Latter part
the same. Saw no whales. 2 Sails in
sight. Thus Ends Lat. 41.27
Sounded found no bottom

Sunday
April 8 Commenced with fresh breezes at
the west. Latter part moderate
Saw no whales. 3 Sails in sight.
Thus Ends 55 fathoms water
Lat. 41.49

Monday
April 9 Commenced with moderate
breezes at the North. Latter part
fresh breezes at N.W. one Sail
in sight. Saw a whale at 10 A.M.
and chased did not faster.
Thus Ends Lat 42.07 50 fathoms

Tuesday
April 10 Commenced with fresh breezes at
the westward. Latter part very strong
gales at S.W. took in wash boat
Saw nothing thus Ends. Sun obscured

Wednesday
April 11 Commenced with strong gales
at S.W. middle and latter part
more moderate. Saw nothing
thus Ends Lat. 40.38
49 fathoms water

Thursday
April 12 Commenced with fresh gales and
suggled at 5 P.M. Saw a whale did
not lower it being too rough. Latter part
Saw nothing thus Ends Lat. 40.49
50 fathoms water

Friday
April 13 Commenced with fresh breezes and
rigid. Latter part moderate. Saw
no whales thus Ends Lat. 41.08
46 fathoms

Saturday
April 14 Commenced with light breezes
at N.W. Steaming S.W. Latter part
fresh gales at N.W. at 11 P.M.
Saw 3 whales but too foggy to
lower thus Concluded
Lat. 42.02

Sunday
April 15 Commenced with fresh breezes at
N.W. at 4 P.M. spoke Ship Fenelon
N. Bedford. Latter part fresh breezes
at W.S.W. Saw several whales and
chased did not faster. Thus Concluded
Saw one in sight. Lat. 42.56
46 fathoms

Monday
April 16 Commenced with fresh breezes
Saw whales and chased did not
faster. Latter part fresh breezes
Saw whales and chased did not
faster thus Lat. 41.55
water 49 fathoms
