

Wednesday
May 2 1838 Commenced with light breezes
and calm later part strong
breezes at the S.W. at 7 P.M.
whales and chased at 10 spoke
Ship Condor of New Bedford
at 11. Threw a whale and sunk the
same this ends 48 fathoms water

Thursday
May 3 Commenced with strong
breezes at the S.W. Saw W
and chased did not fasten
later part fine weather
Saw whales and chased did
not fasten thus ends 48 fathoms
Lat 40.33 South

Friday May 4 Commenced with fine
weather Saw whales and chased
later part foggy Saw a and
chased did not fasten thus
ends Condor in sight
Lat by act 4.35 Sounded
49 fathoms

Saturday
May 5 1838 Commenced with strong
gales at the S.E. at 2 P.M.
Saw whales and lowered did
not fasten later part fine weather
Saw whales and chased did
not fasten thus concluded
50 fathoms water Sun obscured

Sunday
May 6 1838 Commenced with light breezes
and calm later part rainy
Saw whales and chased did
not fasten Spoke Ship
Parachute of New Bedford 1900
thus concluded Sun obscured
50 fathoms

Monday
May 7 Commenced with light breezes
and rainy weather later part
fine weather Saw dead whale
at 6 A.M. took it to the ship
and at noon finished cutting
found it to be the same whale
that sunk on Thursday this ends
Condor of Parachute in sight
50 fathoms Lat 40.30

Tuesday
May 8 Commenced with light breezes
and fine weather Saw no
whales all hands employed in
bailing. Dredged several fathoms
thus concluded Lat 40.24

Wednesday
May 9 Commenced with fresh breezes
at S.W. at 5 P.M. Saw a
and lowered did not fasten
at 9 finished bailing later
part light breezes and calm
Saw whales and chased did
not fasten Employed in
hauling down oil thus ends
3 fathoms in sight Lat 40.25

Thursday
May 10 Commenced with calm Employed
in hauling down oil later part
fresh breezes at S.W. Spoke Ship
Two Brothers of New Bedford 1650
Saw whales on the first part of chase
did not fasten thus ends Lat 40.33
48 fathoms

Friday
May 11 Commenced with fresh breezes and fine
weather Saw whales and chased later
part light breezes Saw a and chased did
not fasten thus concluded Lat 40.18

Saturday
May 12 Commenced with light breezes and calm
Saw whales and lowered did at 8 P.M. took 2 to the ship
Lat 40.03 hooked on and cut one in later part cut in
the other and commenced bailing 2 fathoms in sight
