May 14 Commenced with calm at 2 A.M.
finished boiling Latter part moderate
breeze at 10 A.M. Saw a whale and
chased did not fasten and sail in light
Employed in blowing down oil
Lat. 40.23

Tuesday
May 15 All these 24 hours fine weather
Saw whales and chased did not
fasten thus concludes one ship &
Barque in light Lat. 40.20
50 fathoms

Wednesday
May 16 all these 24 hours fine weather
Saw whales chased could not
fasten spoke ship Joseph
Maxwell of Fair haven 1650
thus ends Lat. 40.43
50 fathoms water

Thursday
May 17 Commenced with fine weather
Saw whales and chased Latter
part fine weather Saw whales got
fast to one pointed thus concludes
2 sail in light 50 fathoms water
Lat. 40.50

Friday
May 18 Commenced with fine weather
Saw whales and chased Middle
part foggy Latter part the same
thus ends Sun obscured
50 fathoms

Saturday
May 19 Commenced with foggy weather
Latter part the same thus
concludes Sun obscured
50 fathoms water

Sunday
May 20 Commenced with light breeze at
N.W. with fog at 9 A.M. cleared
away Saw whales pursued and chased
did not fasten ends with foggy
weather 50 fathoms water Sun obscured

Monday
May 21 These 24 hours thick foggy
weather N.W. Saw nothing thus
concludes Sun obscured 50 fathoms

Tuesday
May 22 All these 24 hours wind N.W.
and foggy Saw no whales thus
ends 50 fathoms water N.W.

Wednesday
May 23 Commenced with moderate
breeze at 1 P.M. came in contact
with a dead whale took it
along side and cut it in
middle part foggy Latter part
fresh breeze at P.W. Employed
in boiling Lat. 40.55

Thursday
May 24 Commenced with strong breeze
at the P.W. Employed in boiling
middle part ruggid at 3 A.M.
finished boiling Latter part still
ruggid Employed in blowing
down oil thus concludes
Lat. 40.18

Friday
May 25 Commenced fresh breeze at the
west and ruggid Middle and
Latter part strong gales at the
P.W. Saw nothing thus ends
Lat. 40.40

Saturday
May 26 All these 24 hours strong gales
and ruggid Saw nothing thus
concludes Lat. 40.30

Sunday
May 27 Commenced with strong gales
at P.W. Latter part more moderate
Saw one sail Lat. 39.30
