got fast to large whale at 7 P.M.
took it to the ship later part
light breeze with a bad sea
Employed cutting thus concludes
Lat. 32.14

Saturday
June 9 Commences with fresh breezes and a bad
sea finished cutting the body of W
later part fresh breezes and veered
still lying with the head thus ends
