June 20th Commenced with light breezes
at N.E. at 1 P.M. Saw an-
other whale and chased did not
fasten the whales going to the N.E.
Middle part calm later just
light breezes at 7 A.M. Saw
a ship at 9 Saw sperm whale
8 miles to windward at 11.30
hauled for them the being 3 1/2 miles

Thursday
June 21st Commenced with light breeze
and calm at 10 P.M. the
boats returned and fetched
a whale later part fresh
breezes at N.W. cut in the
whale thus ends Lat. 32.09
Long 45.30

Friday
June 22nd Commenced with fresh breeze
at 3 P.M. Saw whales at Sun.
Set got within one mile
did not lower later part
fine weather saw nothing
thus concludes employment in
boiling Lat. 31.47
Long 45.50

Saturday
June 23rd Commenced with light breeze
Saw no whales finished boiling
later part fresh breezes with rain
Saw a ship & Brig Steaming N.E.
thus ends employment in steaming
down oil Lat. 31.50 Long 45.30

Sunday
June 24th Commenced with fresh breezes at
N.W. later part fine weather
Saw Finbacks of a Brig Steaming
N.E. thus concludes Lat. 31.38
Long 45.100

Monday
June 25th Commenced with moderate
breezes at the N.W. Ship
heading S.W. Middle part calm
later part the same saw
nothing but finbacks thus
concludes Lat. 31.58
Long 45.100

Tuesday
June 26th Commenced with
with moderate breezes at N.E.
Middle part the same later strong
breezes saw nothing thus ends
Lat. 31.50
Long 47.30

Wednesday
June 27th Commenced with strong gales
at N.W. Middle part more
moderate later wind S.P.E. saw
nothing thus ends Lat. 31.20
Long 46.30

Thursday
June 28th Commenced with fine weather
later part the same saw 2 sails
but no whales thus ends
Lat. 31.30
Long 45.50

Friday
June 29th Commenced with strong breezes
saw nothing
later part strong gales thus
ends Lat. 31.50
Long 47.50

Saturday
June 30th Commenced with strong
gales with rain saw nothing
later part fresh breezes at
W.P.W. Saw a ship heading
N.E. thus ends Lat. 31.14
Long 47.00
