Remarks on board Barque Vappha On a Whaling Voyage Capt Rowland

Tuesday June 1-1852
All hands being on board, at 1 o'clock we got under way with a light breeze from W. S. W.

Wednesday June 2-1852
Begin with fine breeze and pleasant weather from W. S. W. Beating out in company with the Barque Isabella & Active. At 2 o'clock discharged the Pilot the man land bearing S. S. E. Dist 12 miles heading by the wind S. W. E. Middle & Scatter part strong gales
Lat by Obs 39.50 N Long 68-45 W

Thursday June 3-1852
Begin with strong gales from S. to W. S. W. steering S. by S & E. S. E. At 9 o'clock double reef the fore & main topsails and took in the main sail Scatter part more moderate set the main sail and jib saw several sails
Lat by Obs 38-12 N Long by Chron 65-12 W

Friday June 4-1852
Begin with a fine breeze and pleasant weather steering E. S. E. employed in fitting the boats Middle & Scatter part wind and weather the same
Lat by Obs 38-58 N Long by Chron 61-34 W
