Saturday July 17-1852

First part light gales from W steering  
E. N. E. Under all sail. At 5 o'clock spoke  
brig form of Suva nothing. At sun  
set were ship to West and took  
in sail for the night Middle  
part calm latter part light air from  
West heading W. Saw several sails  
Lat by Obs 38-10 N Long by Chron 36-10 W

Sunday July 18-1852

First part light gales from E and pleasant  
weather heading W. At sun set took ship  
to the W Middle part strong gales latter  
part the same took in the light sail  
Saw a steamer and one ship  
Lat by Obs 38-15 N Long by Chron 36-20 W

Monday July 19-1852

First part light gales from E heading  
W. Under all prudent sail Employed  
in setting up the fore topmast rigging  
latter part calm  
Lat by Obs 38-23 N Long by Chron 36-30 W

Tuesday July 20-1852

First part light air and pleasant weather  
Middle and latter part calm Three  
sails in sight  
Lat by Obs 38-30 N Long by Chron 36-40 W

Wednesday July 21-1852

First part light gales from W steering  
W. by E Middle & latter light gales  
from W Saw several sails  
Lat by Obs 39-20 N Long by Chron 37-09 W

# Cruising of the Western Island

Thursday July 22- Capt Howland

First part light gales from W steering  
W by E Under all sail. At sun set  
took in sail for the night and hauled  
to by the wind heading S. E. Middle  
part the same latter part steering  
E Saw Killis several sails in sight  
Lat by Obs 39-28 N Long by Chron 35-54 W

Friday July 23-1853

First part light gales from W steering  
E all sail out at sun set hauled by the  
wind and shorten sail latter part made  
all sail and keep of E Employed  
in setting up the main Rigger Saw  
several sails

Lat by Obs 38-45 N Long by Chron 32-48 W

Saturday July 24-1852

First part light gales from W and pleas  
ant weather steering E at sun set hauled  
by the wind and shorten sail At day  
light made all sail and keep of  
W. N. E. At 11 o'clock keep of E  
Lat by Obs 39-33 N Long by Chron 32-42 W

Sunday July 25-1853

First part light gales from W steering  
E At 2 o'clock spoke Schooner Antaeus  
Three months out 1250 spearm oil At  
sun set hauled by the wind S. E.  
Island of Flores bearing S. E. Dist  
15 Miles

Lat by Obs 39-21 N
