Monday July 26-1852

First part light wind from W steering
between the Is of Corvo & Flores At
2 Oc spoke ship Sylph of Paris. Flown
23 Months out 250 Sp Cill. Middle
part calm Latter part laying
off on on  the Island of Flores
in company with the Sylph
At 9 Oc the Capt went on shore to get
some potatoes & onions discharge 2 Portuges
and shipped three more

First part light air and calm at
6 Oc the Capt came on board & the
Second Mate came of drunk and
abuse the Captain shamefully Middle
part calm Latter part light gales
from W steering W Under all sail
Saw Killers. Lat by Obs 50-21 N

First part light gales from SE heading
SE. At sun set shorten sail a sail
in sight Middle part the same
Latter part employed in cooping
the bread Saw Killers

Thursday July 29-1852

First part light gales from W steering
SE employed in cooping the bread
saw several sails Middle part squally
Latter part At 12 Oc finish cooping the
the bread Saw the Island of Fayal bearing
W Dist 25 Mills. Lat by Obs 39-15 N

First part light gales from SE heading
NW At sun set Fayal bearing SE Dist
15 Mills saw several sails Middle part
more ship to the South Latter part
At 12 Oc spoke Barque  2 Months
out with 20 bbls of Sp Cill St George
bearing S Dist 5 Mills. Corra

of Terceira bearing E Dist 3 Mills

First part light gales from W and squally
At 2 Oc spoke Barque Active 2 Months out
clean. Saw 2 ships both in Terceira bearing
 E, SE. Dist 12 Mills Middle part calm
Latter part At 9 Oc spoke Barque
Thomas Winslow  of Westport 7 Weeks
out 1 hundred of Sp Cill Saw
Killers. No Obs

Monday Aug 2-1852

First part light gales from SE heading
to the Westward at sun set in sail for
the night Middle and Latter part working
up between Terceira and St George
At 12 Oc St George bearing SE Dist 12 Mills
Saw Killers
