Sunday Oct 17-1852

First part strong gales from W steering
N Under short sail At 2 Pm wind hauled
to S W saw Fin Backs At 4 Pm kept of
W E by E Middle part wind and weather
the same Latter part made all
prudent sail At 11 Pm saw right Whale
Landed 3 boats

Lat by Obs 35-30 S Long by Chr 50-50 W

Monday Oct 18-1852

First part the boats still in chase of the
Right Whale At 1 Pm the Leeward boat
struck but could not get a chance to
kill him as he run back and a blowing
on a gale of wind cut the line and came
on board and took in all sail At 7 Pm
close reef the Main topsail heading E
Middle and Latter part blowing a heavy
gale from S.E. lying to under close reef
Main top sail

Lat by Obs 35-22 S Long by Chr 48-48 W

Tuesday Oct 19-1852

First part moderate away from S W
At 5 Pm Made some sail Middle part
more moderate Latter part at day light
made all prudent sail At 7 Pm saw
Right Whales Landed the boats but with
out success came on board and were ship
to the South

On her outward bound Passage
Wednesday Oct 20-1852

First part light air from S E heading
S S W Under all sail saw plenty Fin Backs
Middle part wind hauled to W E At
11 Pm double reef the topsails heading
N S W Latter part strong gales Under
short sail

Thursday Oct 21-1852

First part strong gales from W steering
N S W Under short sail. Saw Fin Backs
Middle part wind hauled to W E
steering N S W Latter part wind
and weather the same

Lat by Obs 40-20 S Long by Chr 50-47 W

Friday Oct 22-1852

First part strong gales from W steering
N W by S At 4 Pm wind hauled to S W
took in the light sails and double
reef the topsails At 6 Pm took in the
and Main sail Middle part more
moderate set the and Main sail
wind from W W At day light made
all sail steering S S W saw Fin Backs

Lat by Obs 41-27 S Long by Chr 50-27 W

Saturday Oct 23-1852

First part strong gales from W W steering
N W At 6 Pm took in the light sails and
double reef the topsails Middle part
wind hauled to S W heading S E
Latter part more moderate made
some sail
