Sunday Oct 24-1852

First part strong gales from W & heading
W. & W. by the wind. At 4 P.M. took in
the light sails & double reef the top
sails. Middle part at 10 P.M. took in the
and main sail. Middle part strong
gales from S.W. took in the fore top sail
and fore sail and bore the ship to
Leat by Obs 45-51 S Long by Chr 51-54 W

Monday Oct 25-1852

First part blowing a gale from S.W. At 5
P.M. more moderate set fore top sail and
Sib. saw one sail. At 8 P.M. set the main sail
Middle part wind and weather the same
Leather part strong gales from W & W. At 8 P.M.
took in the Sib. At 9 P.M. took in the main sail
& fore top sail and fore sail

Leat by Obs 44-55 S Long by Chr 52-20 W

Tuesday Oct 26-1852

First part blowing heavy from the S.W. At
4 P.M. moderate set the fore sail & fore top
sail & Sib. At 8 P.M. wind hauled to W heading
S.W. At 9 P.M. saw a dead right whale not
fit to take along side. Middle part At 9
P.M. set the main sail. Leather part the same
Under double reef topsails

Leat by Obs 45-41 S Long by Chr 53-36 W

Wednesday Oct 27-1852

First part light gales from W to W. heading
S.W. & W. Under all prudent sail. Middle part
wind hauled to S steering to leather part wind
hauled to the Westward ship. Under easy sail
Leat by Obs 46-24 S Long by Chr 56-09 W

On her outward bound Passage
Thursday Oct 28-1852

First part fine gales from W and Pleasant
weather heading S.W. by the wind. At sun
set shorten sail for the night. At day light
made all sail. At 6 P.M. saw sperm
Whales. Leat 8 boats. At 11 P.M. the bar
boat struck and the whale run him out
sight of the ship. And then he cut line &
let him go and came on board

Leat by Obs 46-58 S Long by Chr 56-52 W

Friday Oct 29-1852

First part light gales and pleasant from W. & W.
heading W. At sun down shorten sail.
Middle part came on gradually took in all
sail to a close reef main topsail. Leather
part At 6 P.M. set the fore sail. At 10 P.M. were
ship to S.W. At 12 P.M. set the fore top sail
and Sib. saw nothing

Leat by Obs 46-58 Long by Chr 57-30 W

Saturday Oct 30-1852

First part strong gales from S.W. At 4 P.M. took
in sail to a close reef main topsail. Middle
part the same. Leather part At day light
made all prudent sail. At 7 P.M. were ship
to W wind from S.W. to W. S.W.

Leat by Obs 47-09 S Long by Chr 57-40 W

Sunday Oct 31-1852

First part fine gales and pleasant weather
from W. & W. heading W. by the wind.
At 4 P.M. tack ship to W. At sun set shorten
sail. Middle part under short sail. Leather part
at day light made all sail. At 8 P.M. tack ship
to W. wind hauled to the North steering S.W.
Leat by Obs 48-45 S Long by Chr 57-58 W
