Tuesday Nov 9-1852

First part strong gales from W Under
double reef topsails At sun down shorten
sail and wore ship to E At sail in sight
Middle part squally Latter part fine
gales from W and pleasant weather
At 7 Oc hoop of W and WSE At 12 Oc
hauld up E saw nothing

Lat by Obs 46-37 N Long by Chr 57-18 W

Wednesday Nov 10-1852



First part strong gales from W heading
E At sun set took in sail for the night
and hauld by the wind to W. N. W. Middle
part squally Latter part at day light
made sail kept of W. N. E. At 12 Oc
spoke the Barque Isabella of V. Bedford
Lat by Obs 46-12 S Long by Chr 56-02 W

Thursday Nov 11-1852

First part strong gales from W Under
double reef topsails At 4 Oc took in sail
and wore the ship to Under close reef
Main top sail Middle part heavy squalls
Latter part more moderate set fore sail
and fore top sail and Sic a sail in sight
Wind W. S. W. heading S

Lat by Obs 45-51 S Long by Chr 55-36 W

Friday Nov 12-1852



First part strong gales from W. S. W. Under
double reef topsail and Sic At 1 Oc spoke Barque
Isabella Middle part wind and weather the
same Latter part At 1 Oc set the Main sail.
At 10 were ship to W. N. W.

Lat by Obs 47-35 S Long by Chr 56-01 W

On her outward bound Passage
Saturday Nov 13-1852

First part strong gales from W Under
double reef topsails Sic & Main sail
At 7 Oc took in the Main sail and wore
ship to the W. W. Middle and Latter part
the same At 12 Oc wore ship to W

Lat by Obs 47-37 N Long 56-35 W

Sunday Nov 14-1852



First part strong gales from W heading
W At 4 Oc spoke Barque Isabella of N
Bedford, and exchange signal with
a Dutch Barque At 7 Oc wore ship to
S. W. Middle part wind hauld to S. E
steering W. S. W. Latter part light sail and
foggy saw one sail

Lat by Obs 47-32 S Long by Chr 57-39 W

Monday Nov 15-1852



First part calm At 4 Oc spoke Barque
Isabella Middle part light gales from W
steering S. W. by W Latter part wind hauld
to S. W. heading S At 11 Oc took in the
light quilts and double reef the topsails
a sail in sight

Lat by Obs 48-50 S Long by Chr 60-00 W

Tuesday Nov 16-1852

First part strong gales from W. S. W. heading
W by the wind Under double reef top sails
At 5 Oc took in the Sic & Main sail
and close reef the Main top sail saw
in Backs Middle part blowing a heavy
gale from W. S. W. took in fore top sail
and fore sail Latter part the same

Lat 48-24 S Long 59-53 W
