Monday Jan 17-1853

First part light gales from S steering
W by N under all sail Middle part wind
and weather the same latter part
at 10 we saw the Island of Felix and
Ambrose bearing W. N. W. Dist 15 Miles
O. C. O.

Tuesday Jan 18-1853

First part light air from W. E. steering W. N. W.
and O. C. O. Middle and latter part calm
saw black fish 50 pairs
Lat 25-50 N Long 79-30 W

Wednesday Jan 19-1853

First part calm saw black fish Middle
part and latter part light gales from W. E.
to E. heading N. & W. E. by the wind
Lat by Obs 25-20 N Long by Chr 79-20 W

Thursday Jan 20-1853

First part light gales and pleasant wea-
ther from W. E. steering W. E. Under all
sail Middle & latter part wind and
weather the same steering W. E. saw nothing
Lat by Obs 24-03 S Long by Chr 78-22 W

Friday Jan 21-1853

First part light gales and pleasant
weather from S. E. steering W. E. Under all
sail Middle and latter part no wind
and weather the same steering W. E. by E
Saw nothing of note

Lat by Obs 23-15 N Long by Chr 77-10 W

Whilst cruising on the coast of Chile

Saturday Jan 22-1853

First part light gales from W. E. steering
W. E. by E at 5 P. kept off W. E. Middle and
latter part wind and weather the same
Saw sea birds employed in ship duty
Lat by Obs 22-08 S Long by Chr 74-20 W

Sunday Jan 23-1853

First part strong gales from W. E. steering W. E.
at 4 P. kept off W. E. by W. Under all sail
Middle and latter part wind and weather
the same saw porpoises
Lat by Obs 20-50 S Long by Chr 72-45 W

Monday Jan 24-1853

First part light gales and pleasant weather
from S. E. steering W. E. by W. Under all sail. At
sun down shorten sail Middle part calm
latter part at day light made all sail
steering W. E. by W. at 10 we saw the main land
bearing W. E. Dist 40 Miles
Lat by Obs 19-22 S Long by Chr 71-13 W

Tuesday Jan 25-1853

First part light gales from S. E. heading in
shore at sun down shorten sail and kept
off W. W. a sail in sight Middle part
kept off W. W. W. latter part calm saw S. Birds
Lat by Obs 18-25 S Long by Chr 71-11 W

Wednesday Jan 26-1853

First part light gales and pleasant weather
from S. E. steering W. W. along the land at sun
down shorten sail Middle part wind and
weather the same latter part at 10 P.
steering in shore saw nothing of note
Lat by Obs 17-15 S Long by Chr 71-30 W
