Saturday Apr 30 1853

First part light air from SE heading
heading by the wind to the N. At 4 o'clock
ship to the N. E. a sail in sight. Middle &

Sunday May 1 1853

First part light gales from SE heading by
the wind to the NE at 1 o'clock saw sp. It hales
gain quick to the windward did not lower
the boats. Saw the Barque Henry H. Crope
get a whale. Saw a ship several times
Middle part light gales from SE heading
E. N. E. at 1 o'clock were ship. Latter part
strong gales heading, NE. The Cooper is
sick of duty

Monday May 2 1853

First part strong gales from SE heading
N. E. Saw a Barque among whales saw
for them & saw sp. It hales lowered the boats
but gain to fast to strike came on board
Middle part took ship several times
Latter part light gales from NE heading
N. E. N. Under all sail

Tuesday May 3 1853

First part light gales from SE heading S. S. E.
Under all sail Middle & Latter part
strong gales from SE heading S. S. E.
saw Black fish & Porpoise

Whilst cruising around the Culpeppers

Wednesday May 4 1853

First part light gales from SE heading
S. S. E. at 4 o'clock took ship to the Eastward
saw Black fish Middle & Latter part
light gales from S. S. E. heading E. The
Cooper is very sick do not expect he will
live

Thursday May 5 1853

First part light gales from S. S. E. heading
E. at 3 o'clock saw the Island Culpeppers
bearing S. E. 1st 20 miles Middle part
wind & weather the same Latter part at
day light took ship to S. S. E. saw Fin
Back & Porpoise

Lat by obs 2-02 N Long by obs 91-55 W

Friday May 6 1853

First part light air from S. S. E. heading
S. W. saw Black fish Middle part light
wind from E. N. E. heading S. S. E. & S. E.
at half past 11 o'clock the Cooper died.
his name is James Card belonged to
St John New Brunswick Latter part
at 4 o'clock carried the Cooper

Saturday May 7 1853

First part light gales from SE at 1 o'clock
were ship to the N. E. saw plenty of Fin Backs.
Middle part calm Latter part light
air from E. S. E. heading NE saw Black fish
