Monday May 16-1853

First part strong gales from S.E. steering
W by S Under top sails and courses Middle
part the same latter part steering W
Under all sail At 9 o'clock set fore top
mast standing sail

Lat by Obs 4-20 N Long by Chr 123-29 W

Tuesday May 17-1853

First part strong gales from S.E. steering
W At 5 o'clock kept off W by W set main
Royal employed in cooping the sails
Middle part wind and weather the same
Latter part steering down the sail At
12 o'clock finish

Lat by Obs 5-32 N Long by Chr 124-50 W

Wednesday May 18-1853

First part strong gales from S.E. steering
N by E Middle part wind from W steering
the same latter part wind & weather
the same saw nothing

Lat by Obs 6-22 N Long 125-31 W

Thursday May 19-1853

First part strong gales from S steering W
N W saw no sail Under all sail Middle
part wind S.W steering W.W the squally &
rain latter part hauld to the N.W heading
N.W.E.

Lat 11-10 N Long by Chr 127-45

Friday May 20-1853

First part strong gales from N.W heading N by E
Under all proud out sail Middle light gales
from W steering N.W by S rainy weather
Latter part strong gales from S.W steering
W.W + N.W.W

Lat 13-00 N Long 128-30 W

Whist bound North, Capt Howland
Saturday May 21-1853

First part light gales from S.W steering
W.W Middle part squally latter part
wind S.E steering W.W hauld lower & main
top fore hauld standing sail

Lat by Obs 14-34 N Long by Chr 128-45 W

Sunday May 22-1853

First part light gales from S.S.W steering
W.W Middle part light air & calm from W
Latter part the same

Lat by Obs 15-19 N Long by Chr 128-55 W

Monday May 23-1853

First part light air from W.S.W steering
W.W Middle part light air from W latter
& part calm Employed in setting up & hooking
Lat by Obs 16-27 N Long by Chr 128-55 W

Tuesday May 24-1853

First part light gales from N.W heading
N.W.E Middle part light gales from N.W.W
At 12 o'clock took ship to West latter part wind
and weather the same

Lat by Obs 17-20 N Long by Chr 129-30 W

Wednesday May 25-1853

First part light gales from N.W.E heading
W.W Middle part calm latter part
light air from W heading W.W saw no sail
Lat by Obs 17-55 N Long R 129-10 W

Thursday May 26-1853

First part light air from W heading W
W.W Middle part calm latter part
light gales from N heading W.W the
Calm boat in ship duty

Lat by Obs 18-17 N Long by Chr 129-20 W
