Saturday Nov 5 1853

First part more ship heading NE
fresh gales at sun down both in light
sails. Latter part strong gales from
E & E heading NE saw two backs
Lat by obs 14 27 S Long by obs 82 15 W

Sunday Nov 6 1853

First part fresh gales from NE heading
E, NE saw black fish. Middle part
heading NE by E till 10 AM and then tack
ship heading NE by E to latter part
the same. At sail in sight
Lat by obs 14 27 S Long by obs 81 14 W

Monday Nov 7 1853

First part fresh gales from NE heading
NE by E & E, NE saw black fish at
sun down shorter sail. And were
ship. Middle part at 10 AM were ship
again. Latter part at day light
most sail saw two backs and a sail
Lat by obs 13 44 S Long by obs 82 10 W

Tuesday Nov 8 1853

First part fresh gales heading E, NE
saw two backs at sun down shorter
sail and were ship. Middle part head
ing NE by E. Latter part the same & sail
in sight of two backs & black fish
Lat by obs 14 33 S Long by obs 81 05 W

Wednesday Nov 9 1853

First part strong gales from SE heading NE
at sun down shorter sail. The topsails took in main
sail. Middle part took in fore & main
part at 10 AM set all at 10 AM set the main
sail

Thursday Nov 10 1853

First part fresh gales from NE heading
NE by E & E at sun down shorter sail
and were ship. Middle part at 10 AM
were ship again. Latter part at 10 AM
were ship and made sail. Saw two
backs. 2 sails in sight

Friday Nov 11 1853

First part fresh gales from NE to SE
heading E to E, NE saw two backs
at sun down shorter sail. Middle
part heading NE by E at day light
made sail fresh gales from SE latter
part heading E, NE & saw two backs
Lat by obs 14 33 S Long by obs 80 11 W

Saturday Nov 12 1853

First part fresh gales from NE heading
E, NE at sun down shorter sail. Middle part
at 10 AM were ship. At 10 AM were ship
again. Latter part at day light made
all sail heading E, NE, two sails in
sight. By the gales from SE

Lat by obs 14 15 S Long by obs 79 00 W

Sunday Nov 13 1853

First part light gales from SE heading
SE by E at sun down shorter sail
Middle part at 10 AM shorter sail
Latter part at day light made
sail. At 10 AM kept off

Lat by obs 14 11 S Long by obs 80 27 W
