

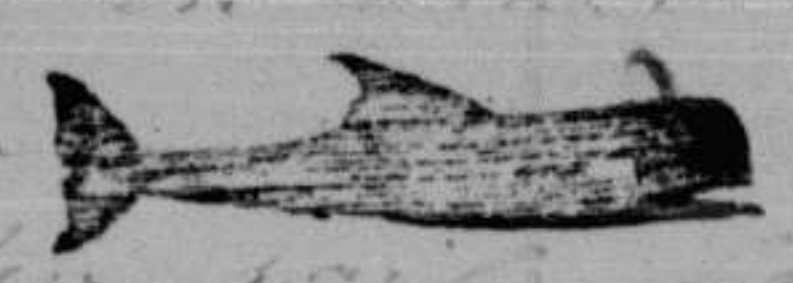
Remarks on board Barque Boppbe

Lat by Obs 13-38 N Long by Chr 77-50 W

Wednesday Dec 24-1853

First part light gales from S.E. spier
ing 11 sun black fish hauled but
without success came on board at
3 P.M. saw more black fish hauled 3
boats got 2 but them in hand &
clear them away at once



down shorter sail latter
part made sail steering
W. Brought out two black fish
Lat by Obs 13-11 S Long by Chr 80-13 W

Thursday Dec 25-1853

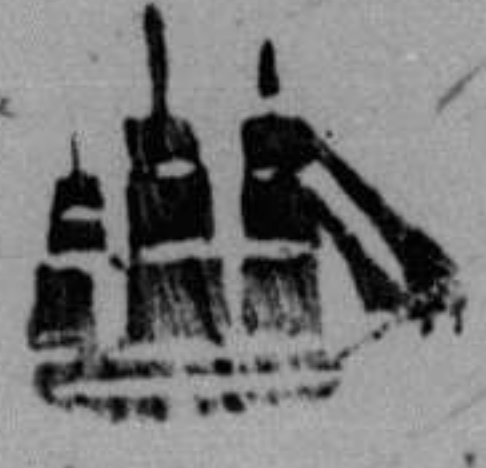
First part a strong Christmas all
First part light gales from S.E. steering
W. At 1 P.M. saw black fish hauled 2
boats but without success came on
board 4 sails in sight At 3 P.M.
spoke William North of Fair Haven
Heard of Captain Howland death
At sun down shorten sail Middle part
heading W. Right air shorter part at day
light in ship & more sail heading
N.E. got 2 sails in sight

Whilst cruising on the Collier Ground
Monday Dec 26-1853

First part light gales from S.E.
heading S.E. spoke ship William
North of Fair Haven At sun down
shorten sail Middle part light
air & on the latter part at
day light made sail finish mending
the main top sail & bent it
saw black fish hauled the boats
but could not start came on
board & more ship to S.W.

Tuesday Dec 27-1853

First part light air from S.E. heading
W. At sun down shorten sail Middle
part shorter sail heading W. Latter
part at day light made sail and more
ship to W.E. & sails in sight fresh
gales from S.E.

Lat by Obs 13-27 S Long by Chr 77-32 W

Wednesday Dec 28-1853

First part light gales from S.E. heading
E. N.E. saw black fish at half past
two P.M. spoke ship Joseph of New
Bedford saw more black fish hauled
for them but without success came
on board At sun down shorten sail
Middle part at 1 P.M. were ship
heading to S.W. of the latter part
at day light made all sail &
sails in sight heading N.E.
Lat by Obs 13-49 S Long by Chr 80-30 W
