made sail 11. sail in sight bearing
W 1/2 N

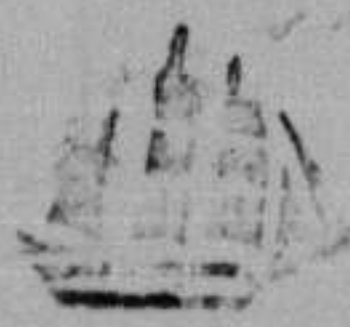


Cruising on the Atlantic ground
Sunday June 1, 1854

I wish you a happy New Year first part
 by the great steam & took a ship to C.
 & C. At 2 P.M. took a ship again to S.
 & C. 3 sails in sight. At one hour shorten
 sail. Middle part landing C. & C.
 Latter part to save 15 lb. fish landed
 all the boats but we have not success
 came on board.
