

Remarks on board Barque Vappho

Wednesday Nov 4 1854

First part were ship to E. & E. strong
gales from W. & W. sail on right
At sun down shorten sail Middle
part of it gales and rain squalls
Latter part light air & calm
heading to the Eastward 2 sails
in sight  Long by Line 80-00 ft
Lat by Obs 14-50 S Long by Chron 80-22 W

Thursday Nov 5 1854

First part light gales from E. & E.
heading at E. Bent the old Main
top gallant sail Shot whole matches
At sun down took ship to the Middle
part heading by E. Latter part At
the back ship again heading S. E.
it sail in sight  Long by the 77-24 ft
Lat by Obs 14-52 S Long by Line 79-04 W

Friday Nov 6 1854

First part same black fish landed
boat got under fresh gales from
E. & E. heading W. & W. At 5 P.M. took
to the Middle part heading S. by S.
Latter part the same strong gales
Lat by Obs 15-44 S Long by the 80-23 W

Saturday Nov 7 1854

First part took ship strong gales
from S. & E. heading E. & E. At 5 P.M. took
the reef the topsails at 7 P.M. took in
the Main sail Middle part heading
S. & E. Latter part At 4 P.M. kept of
N. & E. & made sail At 11 P.M. saw
black fish landed the boats but with
out success same Tin Buck

Cruising on the Callao ground

Sunday Nov 8 1854

First part fresh gales from S. & E.
steering S. & E. At sun down double
reef the topsails and hauld by the
wind to S. & W. Middle part heading
S. & W. Latter part at daylight the
made sail steering N. by E. saw a
Tin Buck At 10 P.M. saw black fish landed
the boats without success came on board
Lat by Obs 14-25 S Long by the 79-29 W

Monday Nov 9 1854

First part light gales from W. & W. steering
S. by E. saw a hump back and plenty
of black fish landed the boats but
could not strike to the canoe on
board & kept of the course At sun
down took in the light sails & hauld
by the wind to W. & W. Middle part at
1 P.M. were ship to E. & E. Latter part
at daylight kept of at saw black fish
landed one but could not strike to it
in sight

Lat by Obs 15-25 S Long by the 79-37 W

Tuesday Nov 10 1854

First part light gales from S. & E. heading
E. & E. At 2 P.M. were ship and steering
W. Took in the back top to repair At sun
down shorten sail and hauld by the wind
to S. & W. Middle part heading with the
back part double Latter part made sail
At 7 P.M. were ship to E. & E. saw a sail
Lat by Obs 15-21 S Long by the 79-50 W
