

Remarks on board Barque Happla

Wednesday June 11 - 1856

First part fresh galley from S. C. heading
E. N. E. 100 lbs. saw black fish inside
the boat it is about 100 ft. long. It
took him on board. We took part of
the ship to S. C. 100 lbs. saw
black fish again. Last part at day
light made sail heading E. S. E. saw
a sail.

Friday Dec 13 1854

First part, pink gales from B. C. showing
 E. by B. some black pit. At sun down
 shorten sail and hauled by the wind
 Middle part heading S. by E. bottom part
 heading S. W. It is the sun up &
 2 sails in sight, and saw a few
 birds

Lat of Res 14-16 S Long of this is 80 W

Wednesday Jan 14 1854

First part spoke ship between of distance
at 18. On the next week he was off of
70 miles of black fish & spoke ship of
of some kind of water. Another part reading
at 6 by C. Latter part at day light
was white and made well at 10 li.
spoke ship. Burque Mercator of some B.C. for
get 70 lbs since we were here last
