Wednesday Feb 8 1854

First part light gales from E. S. E.
hounding S. E. two sails in sight at
sun down shorter sail. Middle part
hounding S. E. sea the part at day
light made sail & were ship
of the ship. Hector of S. B. 14 months
out with 1,000 lbs of Sp. Oil

Thursday Feb 9 1854

First part light gales from S. E. head-
ing S. E. spoke Barque Paulina
& ship Zephyr. At sun down shorter
sail. Middle part hounding S.
S. E. sea the part at day light made
sail. At 6 we were ship to S. E.
Lat by Obs 14-28 S Long by Chr 81-30 W

Friday Feb 10 1854

First part light gales from S. E. head-
ing S. E. spoke ship
Hector of S. B. 14 months. At sun down
shorter sail. Middle part hounding
S. E. sea the part made sail at 9
we saw a dead whale no great
been dead to long

Saturday Feb 11 1854

First part light gales from S. E. head-
ing S. E. At sun down shorter sail
Middle part hounding S. E. sea the
part made sail hounding S. E. &
3 sails in sight unemployed in pain-
ting the Iron work

Lat by Obs 14-37 S Long by Chr 82-07 W

Cruising on the Galapagos ground.

Sunday Feb 12 1854

First part light air from S. E. head-
ing S. E. 3 sails in sight at 6 we
spoke ship Calamba of San Pedro
Middle part hounding S. E. sea the
part at day light were ship &
made sail hounding S. E. & sails
in sight

Lat by Obs 14-59 S Long by Chr 82-14 W

Monday Feb 13 1854

First part fresh gales from S. E.
steering S. E. At sun down shorter
the wind and shorter sail. Middle
part fresh gales sea the part were
ship made sail hounding S. E. &
on bent the bit and repaired it
and bent it again

Lat by Obs 14-45 S Long by Chr 82-20 W

Tuesday Feb 14 1854

First part light gales from S. E. & S.
hounding S. E. & S. At sun down shorter
sail. Middle part hounding S. E.
sea the part at day light made
sail and kept of S. on bent the
main spruce to repair

Lat by Obs 14-30 S Long by Chr 82-20 W

Wednesday Feb 15 1854

First part light gales from S. E.
steering S. E. At sun down shorter sail
& bent by the wind S. E. & S. sea the
part at day light made sail
and kept of S. & sails in sight

Lat by Obs 13-13 S Long by Chr 84-30 W
