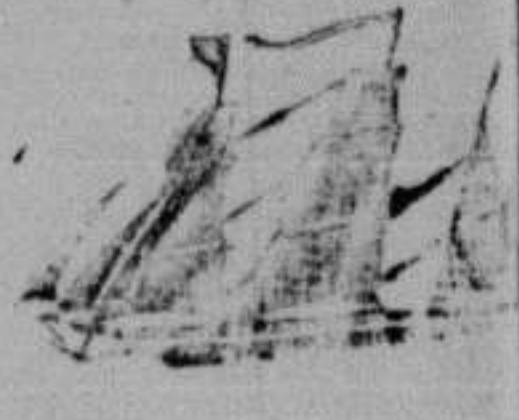


Remarks on board Barque Vaple

for the land in sight

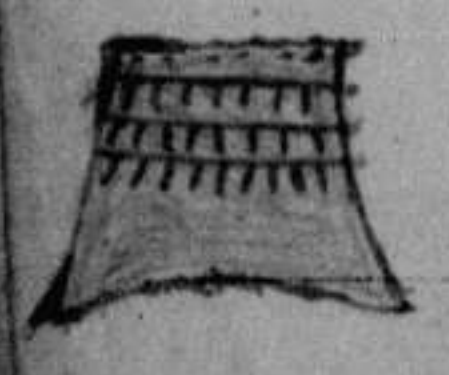

Monday Apr 17-1854

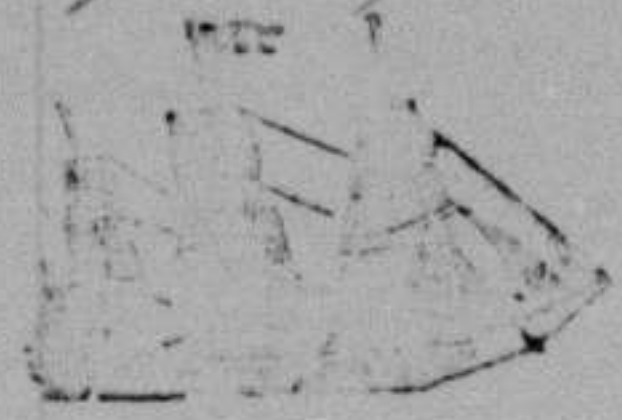
First part light air from S E

Tuesday Apr 18-1854

First part close in to the Culpepper
Is. Finish the main top sail
At 4 Pm spoke the ship
President of Nantucket at 5.30 Pm
of S by E. And 38 men the out
At 5 Pm the land bearing
E by S Middle part heading
ing E by S Latter part
close to the land. The Captain
went in shore with a boat crew
a fishing and never caught a fish

Apr 19-1854

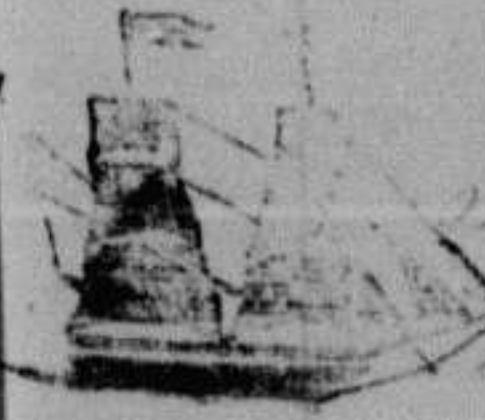
First part light gales from S E heading
