Lat 00-02 N Long by Obs 84-20 W

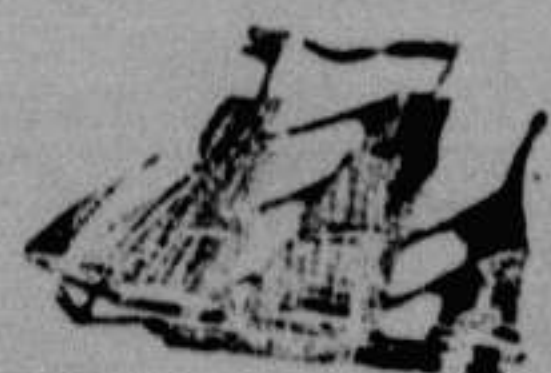
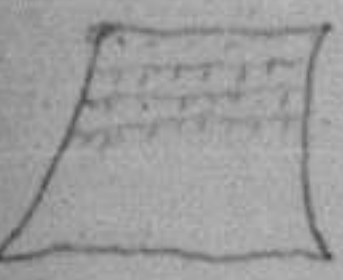
Sunday July 2-1854
