part strong gales and rain squalls.
Under double reef top sails
heading W by N.

Sunday July 14-1854

First part strong gales from S^W
heading W by N. Saw a snake

At sun down were ship to S^E
Middle & Latter part head-
ing S^E. Dry times about here.
I think, what do you think?

Monday July 17-1854

First part fresh gales from S^W
heading S^E by E. At 2 P. saw
the land bearing S^E at 3 P.
were ship. Middle part heading
W by N. Latter part at 6 P. were
ship to S^E.

Tuesday July 18-1854

First part light gales from S^W head-
ing S^E by S. At 1 P. saw the land
bearing E at sun down Middle &
Latter part heading of there.

Wednesday July 19-1854

First part fresh gales from S^W
heading or steering E by N. Middle
part Under short sail heading
W. Latter part At day light
made sail heading W employ-
ed in painting the stern. Work

Long by Chr 81-13 W. by Lunar 81.14 W.
Thursday July 20-1854

First part light gales from S^W
steering E. Middle part at 9
P. were ship. At 1 P. were
ship again. Latter part head-
ing S^E a sail in sight.

Lat by Obs 1-09.8 Long by Chr 80-00

Friday July 21-1854

This 24 hours heading to the
Westward saw nothing of note.
Lat by Obs 1-40.8 Long by Chr 82-46 W.

Saturday July 22-1854

First part light gales from S^W
heading W. Middle & Latter
part the same.

Lat by Obs 2-00.8 Long by Chr 84-11 W.

Sunday July 23-1854

First part light gales from S^W
heading W. Middle part head-
ing W by N. Latter part at
1 P. were ship to S^E.

rain squalls. Saw Fin Backs

Lat by Obs 2-10.8 Long by Chr 85-30 W.
