Wednesday Aug 2-1854

First part slight gales from S, S W heading S E At sun down tack ship to W Middle part heading W Latter part heading W W strong gales took in the light sails Long by Lunar 83-32.74 Lat by Obs 1-45 S Long by Chr 83-40 W

Thursday Aug 3-1854

First part strong gales from S heading W, S W Middle part heading S W Latter part light gales & fog heading S W by W Lat by Obs 1-25 S Long by Chr 83-19 W

Friday Aug 4-1854

First part light gales from S, S E heading S W Saw a Steamer & Schooner Middle part heading W W Latter part the same Lat by Obs 1-40 S Long by Chr 86-45 W

Saturday Aug 5-1854

First part light gales from S, S E heading S W At sun down shorten sail Middle part strong gales Latter part at day light made sail at 4 Ce keep off W & W Lat by Obs 1-46 S Long by Chr 88-50 W

Sunday Aug 6-1854

First part light gales from S, S E steering W At sun down shorten sail Latter part at day light keep off W by W and made sail At 7 Ce saw Hook Is. bearing W by S at 10 Ce hauld by the wind to E, E E Lat by Obs 1-26 S Long by Chr 89-00 W

Around Hood Island

Monday Aug 7-1854

First part light gales from S E by W Hood Is bearing W, S W Dist 20 Miles

At sun down Chatham Is in sight bearing W by W Dist 20 Miles Middle part heading E by E Latter part light air and fog heading S E by E Lat by Obs 1-00 S Long by Chr 88-50 W

Tuesday Aug 8-1854

First part light air from E, S E heading S E by E Chatham Is bearing W W Dist 15 Miles At sun down took in

the light sails Middle part heading E by S Latter part at day light made sail Employed in mending the Main top & allant sail Heading E by N

Lat by Obs 00-36 S Long by Chr 88-30 W

Wednesday Aug 9-1854

First part light gales from S, S E heading E Spoke the Barque Pan Lina of New Bedford 350 lbs of Sp all Middle part heading E Latter part thick and rain Employed in clearing the pumps

Lat by Obs 00-18 S Long by Chr 88-06 W
