

Remarks on board Barque Hippo
Tuesday Oct 10-1854

First part light gales from S. S. W. steering S. E. Employed in repairing Main top gallant staysail. At sun down took in the light sail & wore ship to W. Middle part lying with the Main yard a back. Latter part heading to the Eastward.

Lat by Obs 22-15 N Long by Chr 81-15 W

Wednesday Oct 11-1854

First part light gales from S. S. W. steering S. Middle part At 12 O'clock hauled by the wind, with the Main yard a back and lay till day light. Latter part went down the Main yard to fix the bands & sent it up again, repaired the Main sail and bent it. Heading to the Eastward. 2 sails in sight.

Lat by Obs 22-35 N Long by Chr 80-49 W

Thursday Oct 12-1854

First part fresh gales from S. S. W. steering S. S. W. At sun down shortened sail & hauled by the wind.

Middle part heading W. by S. Lat for part At day light wore ship to S. S. E. & made sail fresh gales from S. W. Employed in mending sails.

Cruising for Sperm Whales
Friday Oct 13-1854

First part fresh gales from S. W. heading S. S. E. At sun down shortened sail. Middle part under short sail. Latter part steering E. & S. E.

Lat by Obs 1-02 N Long by Lunar 81-07 W

Saturday Oct 14-1854

First part light gales from S. S. W. steering S. W. At 6 O'clock hauled by the wind to W. Middle part heading W. Latter part heading W. by S. fresh gales from S. S. W. thick weather.

Lat by Obs 2-00 N Long by Chr 82-00 W

Sunday Oct 15-1854

First part fresh gales from S. S. W. heading S. E. thick rain squalls. Middle part heading E. S. E. Latter part At 10 O'clock saw a Sp. Whale & lowered the boats in chase of him.

Lat by Obs 00-58 N Long by Chr 82-01 W

Monday Oct 16-1854

First part in chase of the whale. At 5 O'clock came on board & gave up the chase after the whale could not get near him. Back luck to him. At sun down shortened sail heading S. E. Middle part At 8 O'clock wore ship to W. Latter part At day light made sail & wore ship to S. E. At 9 O'clock dabbled reef the top sails.
