Thursday July 5th Commences with brisk breezes from the S^W steering N^W 5 P^m saw a sail of the lower running of 7 P^m had a hard rain Isaacall hauld up the laces and took two reef in the top sails middle and lower part this part heading to the S^E in ployd in Ships duty Lat 38 19 Long 35 23

Friday July 6th Commences with light breezes from the S^W 1 P^m wore ship to the word this part in ployd in Ships duty Sundown wore ship heading to the S^E took in sail middle and lower part heading to the word 1 P^m broke out the broad shaft the main hatch and coopered it Lat Long

Saturday July 7th Commences with light air and carries ship heading to the N^W this part in ployd in Coopering broad and flower 4 P^m got down a reef the hatch 5 P^m saw a sail ahead wore ship wind hauld to the word Sundown took in sail for the night middle and lower this part in ployd in pairing the bow boat Lat Long

Sunday July 8th Commences with light breezes steering of saw the bark Elabonier late her to be a whaling 6 P^m spoke her but she had not seen any thing since we saw her last 10 P^m wore ship heading to the North Wind N^W later part saw a schooner steering N^E So ends Lat 38 45 Long 35 33^W

Monday July 9th Commences with brisk breezes from the N^W for banks with rain 4 P^m saw a bark to the west of Stern of us this part steering to the S^E 7 P^m saw a ship standing to the N^E under double reef top sails 8 P^m we drift by the wind to the word middle and lower part 7 P^m wore ship to the S^E wind N^E So ends this 24 hours Lat Long

Tuesday July 10th Commences with strong breezes from the S^E heading to the S^E under double reef top sails till beams in ployd in washing Sundown wore ship to the N^W middle part light breezes later part heading to the word 11th light birds saw two sail to leeward Wind from the North this part in ployd in Ships duty Lat 38 22 N Long 36 03^W

Coopering on the western ground

Thursday July 11th Commences with light breezes from the N^W heading to the word with all sail out in ployd in Ships duty and so forth 5 P^m saw the sail of the lower merchant men saw one took in sail middle and lower part in ployd in breaking out Cooper flower forward of the main hatch Lat 38 22 Long 35 40

Thursday July 12th Commences with light breezes from the N^W steering to the S^E saw a sail running of a cross the lower 6 P^m spoke her the ship Daniel Wood of New Bedford with 12 barrels sundown took in sail Carve middle and lower this part in ployd in Coopering the broad and flower 10 P^m inward two boats for whales thony proved to be grampes the King N^W light So ends Lat 38 18 Long 35 34^W

Friday July 13th Commences with light breezes from the S^W in ployd in steering of 1 P^m the boats came on board 6 P^m saw whales breaching of the tubcom they were coming sick to windward toward three boats for them and they proved to be grampes gave them up and came on board and took in sail and ployd with the main yard a back middle and lower part this part light breezes from the S^W saw two sail bound to the word this part in ployd in Ships duty So ends this 24 hours Lat 38 30 Long 36 00

Saturday July 14th This part commences with brisk breezes from the N^W heading to the N^W in ployd in Ships duty 4 P^m saw a sail 4 points of the lower 8 made her out to have a whale could hear the Daniel Wood Sundown saw spouts 4 points of the spout or two out word not make them out middle and lower part this part heading to the N^W saw two sail running of saw grampes this part in ployd in washing Ship So ends Lat 38 22 Long 35 52

Sunday July 15th Commences with light breezes heading to the S^E 1 P^m saw a Ships Bow Sprit this part in ployd in washing Ship Sundown wore ship to the N^W took in the light sails middle and lower part Carved this part heading to the N^W all sail out Lat 38 2 Long 35 44
