in Sail hiding S E by E mid and later part
Strong breezes from the E N E hiding to the S E So ends
Lat 36.34 Long 36.17

Thursday July 19th Commences with strong breezes
from the E and 1 P m wore ship Steering E N E this part
in playd in lapping the fore top mast rizen Sundown
took in Sail gill and main sail mid and later part hid-
ing to the North in playd in Steering S W by W Lat 36.36 Long 36.50

Friday July 20th Commences with brisk breeze from the E N E
1 P m wore ship to the S saw two sail of the a bow
this part in playd in Ships duty 5 P m latched ship
to the North with a large ship of the le quarter
Steering to the North Sundown took in the top sail
and fly gill mid and later part 5 A m made all
Sail Steering S E by N in playd in Ships duty 36 46

Saturday July 21st Commences with fresh breezes from
the E S E in playd in Ships duty Sundown took in Sail
hiding to the N E mid and later 5 A m kept of N W
saw two sail merchant men this part saw nothing
So ends Lat 38.36 Long 36.37 W

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Sunday July 22nd Commences with brisk breezes from the S E

Steering on a zig zag course 1 P m saw 6 brig cross our
side this part in playd in Ships duty Sundown took in Sail
and kept by the wind to the E and mid and later part
5 A m made all sail kept of to the North saw two sail

Monday July 23rd Commences with light breezes from
the S E saw a whaling brig 3 P m saw black fish
wards the harbor boat for them but they were to curing for
me gave them up and came on board 6 P m spoke the brig
Vindese horta of Sicall Captain Sylva master none whale
hairs mouth out mid and later part 5 A m made all
sail and Steered to the westward saw two sail Steering
to the E and this day wash day Lat 37.15 Long 37.26

Tuesday July 24th Commences with brisk breezes from the
S S W Steering W N W 3 P m saw a brig Steering to the
E and saw down took in Sail mid and later part
5 A m made all sail Steering W N W this part
in playd in splicing in the mizen rizen and so forth
Lat 37.25 Long 37.34 W

Wednesday July 25th Commences with light breezes from
the Word Steering S W in playd on the mizen rizen
Sundown took in Sail thick over cast weather
mid and later part 5 A m made all sail this part
Steering S W this part in playd in the mizen rizen
Lat 37.46 Long 37.41 W

Thursday July 26th Commences with light breezes
from the S E Steering S W and S in playd on the
mizen rizen Sundown took in Sail and wore ship to the
E and mid and later part 5 A m made
all sail and Steered S W in playd in the mizen
rizen and on the fore top mast rizen put rizen
on so saw rolling sounds this part Lat 41.12 Long 39.37

Friday July the 27th Commences with brisk breezes
Steering S W in playd in the mizen top mast back
stung mid and later part 5 A m made all sail this part
on the wind in playd on the mizen rizen
Lat 41.37 Long 39.25
