N.W. heading to the N.W. under double reef top sails and
course got and spanker middle and later 5 A.M. maid
sail Ware ship to the N.W. this part 6 A.M. hauld in
ployd in Wash ing Lat 37.55 Long 37.40 W

Tuesday Aug 14th Commences with Strong breezes from the E. and
heading to the N.W. 4 P.M. saw black fish toward three
boats for them and gave Chais to windard they war
to fast for us gave them up and came on board Ware
ship heading S.E. Strong breezes Sundown took in sail
middle and later part 5 A.M. Maid sail Strong
breezes from the S.E. 3 Ware ships Lat 37.38 Long 37.36

Wednesday Aug 15th Commences with Strong breezes heading

sail Sundown took in sail heading East E. Wind
middle and later Wind light 5 A.M. maid sail
and got up the labels to Set up the fore rig in
6. Saw Whales got breakfast and toward 4 boats
so got fast Lat and W.B. the rest gave
Chais Lat 37.45 Long 37.15
