Friday Sep 7th Commences with gails from the E N E

heding S E all of this part. Saw a vessel lying too of the
leguarter. Sundown blowing hard. Middle and later part
blowing hard from the N E heding E by S under double
reef top Sails. Lat 31.40 Long 30.32 W.

Saturday Sep 8th Commences with Strong breezes from the N E
heding E by S. With light squalls of rain. P M Sat the
main sail with a heavy head out. In middle and later Wind light
from the Eord this part in plogd in breaking out for water.
And the cooper coopers the oil in cask 3 casks. Long 27.14
Lat 31.18

Sunday Sep 9th Commences with light airs. P M were ship
to the North this part in plogd in breaking out for hard coal
And so forth. P M A L. Sted of Sundown heding N by E
Wind E N E. Middle and later part this part heding E S E
P M were ship to the North. So ends. Lat 31.33 Long 27.16

Monday Sep 10th Commences with light breezes from the
E N E. Wind haling - Saw three sail this part. P M lashed
Ship to the North with all sail out. Middle and later part
P M in saw pike and pike 41 miles of huring N N E
this part light airs and carries. Saw four sail. Lat 31.38
Long 28.42 W.

Tuesday Sep 11th Commences with light airs from the
Eord this part round and round. P M heding N N W
middle and later part this part in plogd in washing Ship.
Carrie. Saw 20 Sails. Lat 31.8 Long 27.36 W.

Wednesday Sep 12th Commences with light airs from the N N W
heding in for payal this part in plogd in washing
Ship. P M were Ship and stood of shore to
late to go on shore with the wind N W heding N S W
middle and later part P M the Captin went on
shore. At 11 A M sent the oil in cask 3 casks.

Thursday Sep 13th Commences with fresh breezes heding up and on

Sundown the Captin came of with 4 men short run away.
And Shift 4 Sails yes. This part standing out
with the chain boat middle part Strong breezes heding
S E later part Wind a bit a did not up to payal
So ends.

Friday Sep 14th Commences with Strong breezes from the E
P M the Captin went on shore to get the remainings
they caught two of them and Shift none more
portugle. Sundown the Captin came of with two of
the run a ways. This part Steering N P M Steer
ing S E. middle and later part out in middle
sail heding S E by S in plogd in Steering in
cable and getting out water. Lat 31.35 Long 28.41

Saturday Sep 15th Commences with Strong breezes
from the E N E heding S E for St Marys
Sundown took in the fly gib and took two reef in the
top Sails. Thick and over cast wither middle and
later part fresh breezes out in mail all sail
heding S E by S. This part in plogd in Ships
duty and so forth. Lat 36.25 Long 26.17 W.

Sunday Sep 16th Commences with fresh breezes from
the Eord. Saw a ship on the wither beam. P M
the Bark Sappho top of S W per compass. With the
wind from the Eord middle and later part Steering S W
with all sail out. Lat 34.42 Long 26.11

Monday Sep 17th Commences with light breezes
from the N W Steering S S W with all sail out
middle and later this part Steering S S W with all
sail out in plogd in washing. Lat 33.0 Long 26.15

Tuesday Sep 18th Commences with light airs from
the N E Steering S S W. P M Saw two Sails
Steering by the Wind to the W ord. Middle and later
part light breezes this part in plogd in repairing
the main sail this part. Saw a bark standing
Word. So ends. Lat 32.7 Long 26.17
