Friday Oct 26th Commences with fresh breezes - Steering S.W. by W
this part saw two Steamer who called them by their Sums
this part set up the main top mast back stay on the S Side
and top gallant and I fresh middle and later part this part
imployed in breaking out a bunt the fore hatches for
water and filled them with salt water Lat 23 32 W
Long 41 20 S

Saturday Oct 27th Commences with light breezes from
the S.W. heading S.W. by S imployed in filling salt water
5 P.M. all Stowed 7 P.M. heading S by E Wind W S.W.
middle and later part this part imployed in ships
duty and I fresh Lat 24 37 Long 42 45

Sunday Oct 28th Commences with light breezes
during S.W. imployed in sheering the main lifts
and fore and middle and later this part light breezes from
the S.E. Steering S.W. by S Lat Long

Monday Oct 29 Commences with light breezes from the S.E.
Steering S.W. by S saw nothing sundown set the main sail
middle and later part this part wash day all hands
imployed in washing close Lat this part
Steering S.W. by S Lat 26 55 Long 45 W

Tuesday Oct 30 Commences with fresh breezes from
the S.E. Steering S by W Sundown set the main sail
middle and later part this part imployed in mending the
main top sail with fresh breezes from the W.W. Steer-
ing S. by W. With all sail out Lat 27 44 Long 45 44

Wednesday Oct 31 Commences with fresh breezes from the W.W.
imployed on the sail 4 P.M. Wind north of backed ship
to the W.W. 8 P.M. backed ship to the S.E.
middle and later part this part heading S.S.W. Wind W
imployed in mending the main top sail and
I fresh noon All done mended it up and
stowed it in the sail pen Lat 30 33 Long 45 45 W

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Thursday November 1st Commences with strong breezes from
the S.W. heading S.E. by E this part imployed in mending
the gift 1 P.M. saw breeches of the leeward keel for them
they proved to be hump backs left to the wind
7 P.M. heading S.E. by E middle and later part this part
came imployed in mending the fore sail and I fresh
Lat 31 27 Long 44 22 W

Friday Nov 2nd Commences with breezes imployed
on the fore sail 5 P.M. all done mended up and stowed
it in the sail pen this part set up the S.E. Side of
the main top gallant rigging middle and later part
this part Steering S.W. by S imployed in breaking out
the larboard side of the fore hole aft and pumping the
fresh water and filling it with salt water the ground
Lat 32 27 Long 45 22

Saturday Nov 3rd Commences with light breezes from
the W.W. heading S.W. imployed in filling salt water
5 P.M. all Stowed of the head and flower compass
middle and later part 5 P.M. blowing hard from
the S.E. Steering S.W. by W half past 6 took in the
light sails and took the reef in the fore top sail
two in the main this part usually Lat 33 46 Long 46 54

Sunday Nov 4th Commences with strong winds from
the S.W. Steering S.W. by S imployed in ships duty
middle and later part strong breezes from the S.E.
Steering S.W. with all sail out Lat 36 47 Long 47 11

Monday Nov 5th Commences with strong breezes
from the S.E. Steering S by W 3 P.M.
took in the light sails and main sail and two
reef in the fore top sail middle and later part blowing
at moderate gale from the S Steering S by W
Running under a double reef fore top sail and single reef main
with the main top gallant sail set over it
Lat Long
