Friday Nov 30th Commences with the Wind from the S W bore ship
and stard S W by N W. With a heavy bed but soon at work
up out of the main top sail and set the main top gallant sail
over it. Gave ship sail and got 1 P M heavy snow squalls from the
S W made the line later Wind a bed heading S S W
Soon bore ship to the S S W Lat 54 21 Long 75 46 W

Saturday Dec 1st Commences with strong breezes from
the S W heading W S W thick and rainy under two double
reef top sails 7 P M bore ship heading S W by N
Wind S W middle part lying to under a close reef main
top sail 7 P M Wind S by N of S W more haul to the S W
look in the fore and main top gallant sails Lat Long

Sunday Dec 2nd Commences with a moderate gale from
the S W steering S W with single reef top sails 2 P M
Close reef the top sails usually 7 P M the same
middle part steering S W later part back of S W by N
Lat 52 Long 79 36

Monday Dec 3rd Commences with strong breezes from
the S W steering S W 3 P M Close reef the fore and
main top sail and look in the main sail and stard
S W heavy squalls from the S W Lat middle part fresh gales
from the S W steering S W under close reef top sails

Tuesday Dec 4th Commences with the Wind from the South
with fresh breezes steering S 1 P M all sail out 7 steering
S by E with square yards and light & middle gale later
part steering S S E with all sail out Wind light from
the S and this part in play in fitting S W cutting gales

Wednesday Dec 5th Commences with light air from the S steering
S S E 2 P M Wind S W light air middle part fresh breezes
from the W steering S S E later part steering S by E
Wind W S W blowing fresh till sail out thick fog
and rain in play in pointing the cutting gales

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Thursday Dec 6th Commences with strong breezes from the S W

steering S by E 4 P M washed up the decks & heaped S E
for cap three mountains I look in the light sails and
stard the main sail middle part lying a back later part
2 P M saw the land learned he of S W under double reef
top sails Lat 45 Long 76 11 W

Friday Dec 7th Commences with strong breezes from the South
steering S S W 5 P M saw sperm whales the Captain
bore ship and toward two more boats for them the
sickent main boat steered at once as he
past the boat but to far of gave them up and came
in round dark this part steering S S W middle and
later part this part round down to grasp moon sea
the land 25 Miles of Sperm Whales a going to windward

Saturday Dec 8th Commences with fresh breezes from the S
half past 1 P M toward for sperm whales 4 boats the
boat struck a large whale the sickent
boat took him to the ship two from the
the floop chain parted and lost him and found
him the next day sounds

in cutting 12 P M the head of and body in Lat
the watches day light began on the to cut the head

Monday Dec 10th Commences with moderate breezes from
the S W in play in bailing the last 6 P M steered
the works on head 1 P M Lat the watch
middle part in play in bailing head later the same
