Steering E.S.E. with all Sail out this part saw porpoises
middle and later & A.M. set the gib and Spanker this part
in ployd on the riggen 10 took two reef in the top Sails
gib and Spanker and kept of E.S.E. Wind N.W.
blowing fresh Lat 34.12 Long 71.51 W.

Wednesday Apr 10th Commenced with strong breezes from the
N.W. 1 P.M. heading to the Northward and East in ployd
on the riggen Sundown took in the fore top Sail and wore
Ship to the S.W. Middle part strong breezes & A.M. set the
fore top Sail & A.M. made Sail this part Wind S.W. heading to the

Steering to the South East this part in ployd in wash
ing and the Seckart mate in ployd in making a
rudder 6 P.M. made fore baring W. point. E. by N.
middle and later part 6 A.M. took in the light Sails
this part Steering E. by N. to N. 10 saw Joan for mander
this part in ployd in getting a raft ready for water
Lat 34.05 Long 71.02
