ing 8 A.M. kept at N.W. Lat 27 7 Long 79 43

Monday Ap 29th Commenced with light breeze from the
South steering N by W. Saw nothing Sundown took in
the light sails and hauled up the fore sail middle and later
part this part hiding to the Word with all sail out
the watch in plough in washing close saw fin backs
Lat 21 3 Long 79 37 1/2

Tuesday Ap 30th Commenced with brisk breezes from the
South hiding to the Word with all sail out the watch
in plough in washing this part saw nothing out
birds at 8 pm fore ship to the E out saw the land of
the leeward Sundown took in all sail but the two top sails
middle part wind light later 6 A.M. made all sail
at 8 pm got up the old fore sail and fitted the takers
Lat 20 5 Long 77 34

Repairing Sails

Wednesday May 1st off St. Ambrose.

Commenced with light breezes from the S steering
E per compass this part bent the old fore sail
and began on the new one to repair it middle part
wind from the Word later part in plough in repairing the
new fore sail hiding to the North Lat 26 15 Long 78 19

Thursday May 2nd Commenced with brisk breezes from the W
hiding to the North in plough on the fore sail at 3 P.M. all day
made it up and stowed it in the sail room Sundown took in
all middle part light breezes later 6 made sail
this part sent the main royall mast down and
sat a rain on and fitted the rig and sent it and
the main royall yard up Lat 25 21 Long 78 36 1/2

Friday May 3rd Commenced with brisk breezes from the
W.N.W. hiding W and S.W. with all sail out in plough in
taring and putting on batten and fitting the stay Sell penon's
Sundown took in the light sails at 8 pm hiding N.W.
middle part and later part at 8 pm made sail this part in
plough in ripping up the old main royall and fitting and
stowing the stay Sell penon's with stut Lat 24 22 Long 78 00

Saturday May 4th Commenced with brisk breezes from the
North hiding E.S. in plough in putting on ratlings on
the main and top mast rigging at 8 pm tacked ship
hiding N.W. by W middle and later part hiding from
N.W. to W strong breezes from light sails in
Lat 23 46 Long 78 10

Sunday May 5th Commenced with strong breezes from
the N.W. hiding W by S sails got up sail out and fitted
this part in plough in ship's duty middle and later
part at 8 pm tacked ship to the E wind N.W. this part
light breezes saw nothing Lat 23 07 Long 78 29

Monday May 6th Commenced with light breezes from
the W.N.W. hiding N.W. this part saw a black run
for it it was fin backs at 8 pm hiding N by E
wind light middle part came later the same this part
wash day Lat 22 31 Long 78 07 1/2

Tuesday May 7th Commenced with light airs from
the S.W. steering W by S the watch in plough in wash
ing at 8 pm saw fin backs at 8 pm steering W by S with
all sail out middle and later part this part steering W by S
in plough in setting up the two stays and backropes
and got stay Lat 22 27 Long 77 21

Wednesday May 8th Commenced with light airs and calms
this part in plough in setting up the fly jib stay and the capstan
in plough in painting his boat middle and later part
came in plough in traking out for meat
Lat 22 29 Long 77 33
