ing N W in ployd in making Spungarn 2 P M
Steering N W saw a fin back Sundown took in
sail and left by the wind to the N E middle part
laying with the head yards a back later part Steering in ployd
in making Spungarn Lat 18 56 Long 11 14

Saturday June 15th Commenced with brisk winds
Steering of SW in ployd in braking out for place under
water in the main hatch. Seckout her in the lower hole
and filled it with salt water Sundown took in sail
and left to the wind to the S E with head yards a back
middle and later part this part Steering of saw black fish
and porpoises and fin backs Lat 19 11 Long 11 51 W

Sunday June 16th Commenced with fresh winds in ployd
in scraping top mast 8 1 P M left to the wind to the S E
saw fin backs Sundown took in sail middle and later part
sawally heading to the S Lat 19 7 Long 11 36 W

Monday June 17th Commenced with strong winds with
sawally 3 P M saw a school of porpoises Sundown took
in sail heading to the N E middle and later part
strong winds heading to the S Lat 19 11 Long 11 35

Tuesday June 18th Commenced with strong winds with
sawally this part saw fin backs Sundown wore
ship to the N E middle and later part this part
in ployd in over hauling the main top mast brace
blocks this part saw nothing heading to the
south Lat 19 17 Long 11 13 W

Saturday June 22nd Commenced with strong winds

middle and later part in ployd in making Spungarn
strong winds heading South Lat 19 17 Long 11 24 W

Sunday June 23rd Commenced with strong winds
heading to the South sawally double reef top sails
gib and spanker middle part later part heavy squalls
head to the N E 11 A M saw a sail on the mother
bow running for us Lat 19 14 Long 11 35 W

Monday June 24th Commenced with strong winds 11 0 P M
spoke the bark Anconda the Captain went on board
and got the letters a came on board this part heading to the
N E Sundown took in the gib and spanker middle sawally
later strong winds in ployd in washing saw
none fin back Lat 19 5 Long 11 27 W
