Friday July 26 Commences with light trawls heading
 to the South with all sail out saw nothing Sundown
 Ware ship to the North and took in sail middle part
 19 smalls later part in playd in ship's duty this part
 stowing S.W. trawls light all sail out Lat 19 25 Long 70 25

Saturday July 27 Commences with light trawls stowing
 1 W in playd in washing the ship aft for painting
 in side and cleaning the pots Sundown took in sail
 middle and later part this part in playd in
 painting in side gally and potatoe pen and as far
 as the brake this part thick over cast Lat 19 45
 Long 70 56

Sunday July 28 Commences with brisk trawls over
 cast wither heading to the N.E. saw none fin back Sun
 down took in the light sails middle and later part
 heading to the South with all sail out Lat 19 31 Long 70 41

Monday July 29 Commences with light trawls
 heading to the South with all sail out and a heavy
 swell from the S.W. Sundown took in sail middle
 and later part this part light trawls in playd in
 washing 10 A.M. came Lat 19 45 W
 Long 70 46
