Sunday Sep 15 Commenced with strong tides half past 12
started the work - in play in both the case and had
later part gone all out. Lat 19 35 Long 11 11

Monday Sep 16 Commenced with strong tides in
play in both on the body & 3 m saw a sail of
the Sutter & 3 m took up two of the ground
in the fore hole shifted cash middle and later
part in play in both in strong tides
heading to the S.E. Lat 19 41 Long 11 19 W

Tuesday Sep 17 Commenced with strong tides heading
to the Sutter in play in both in later part
1 1/2 m on the part line & all in this part
all hands in play in washing close ship heading to
the S.E. under double reef top sails Lat 19 40 Long 10 51

Wednesday Sep 18 Commenced with strong tides in
play in washing under short sail Sundown wore
ship to the S.E. middle and later part half past 5 A.M.
hauled out cash and began to cooper the oil for stowing
morn all coopered 80 barrels this part heading to the Sutter
Saw porpoises Lat 19 36 Long 10 43

Thursday Sep 19 Commenced with fresh tides heading
to the Sutter in play in filling up the cash for
stowing full Sundown wore ship to the S.E. with
A.M. main top sail on fly 1/2 and yaff top sail
middle and later part half past 5 wore ship to the S.
in play in breaking out in the fore hole on the S.E.
side for stowing oil Lat 19 53 Long 10 40

Friday Sep 20 Commenced with fresh tides in play in
stowing oil took up all of the ground and replaced them
at dusk all down but wore middle and later part
this part in play in stowing off Lat 20 18
Long 10 35 W

A. Crossing on the Acher ground for sperm whales
Saturday Sep 21st Commenced with strong tides heading
to the Sutter this part in play in breaking out in the fore
peak for pipe Shook for water dark rock of wore ship
to the S.E. and took two reef in the main top sail
middle and later part this part in play in taking up
all of the ground on the larboard side and found them all
good but two large worn broken staves replaced them
and filled them with salt water Lat 19 45 Long 10 15 W

Sunday Sep 22nd Commenced with strong tides heading to the
S.E. in play in the fore hole Sundown & 3 m hauled a
cask middle and later part fresh tides Lat 19 27 Long 10 14

Monday Sep 23 Commenced with fresh tides heading to the
Sutter 1 P.M. Sat. the gib and Spanker steering S.W.
by S. Sundown took in the gib and Spanker middle and later
part half past 5 began in the fore hole this part head-
ing to the Sutter under short sail in play in
stowing of the fore hole and all forward of the main hatches
Lat 19 41 Long 10 45

Tuesday Sep 24 Commenced with light tides heading S
in play in the fore hole Cooper in play in setting up
pipes for water 5 P.M. fore hole Shook of and wore
side of the lower decks middle and later part this
part in play in stowing of the after hole Lat 19 54 Long 10 47

Wednesday Sep 25 Commenced with fresh tides in play
in stowing off the after hole 3 P.M. all stowed off and all
a balt the blubber room hauled forward of the blubber room.
And wore side stowed off with empty pipes for water the
Cooper in play in setting up pipes for the S.E. side middle
and later part this part finished clearing up Lat 19 47
Long 10 27

Thursday Sep 26 Commenced with fine tides heading South
this part in play in setting up Shooks 4 P.M. washed
off the decks Sundown took in sail. middle and later part
employed in finishing the Shooks 4 P.M. saw sperm
Whale and Howard & boats per him an gave chase
Lat 19 34 Long 10 31 W
