with a thick fog in play in cutting. Middle part
in play in cutting later the same this part
saw two sail Lat Long

Wednesday Jan 22nd Commences with Strong breezes from
the S.E. in play in cutting on the body later part
the old the morning light have a back of bread
210 gallons and returned the back Lat 43 22 Long 75 27

Thursday Jan 23rd Commences with Strong breezes
from the S.E. under double top Sails in play in
cutting this part saw 3 sail this part the moon
quarter middle part thick fog in play in cutting
1 A.M. all three and commenced on the fat lean
this part foggy by Spels Lat 43 32 Long 75 30

breezes from the W.S.W. 1 P.M. took in the get
and Spunk 7 P.M. blowing Strong took in the
fore top sail with land a Spar 17 miles of
middle part raft the fore sail later part moderate
Saw two sail this part small all sail Lat 43 43
Long

Monday Jan 27th Commences with light breezes from
the W. heading to the S. this part middle part better fair
later part Wind cutting from S to W this part
saw 2 sail better fine all sail out Lat 43 12 Long 75 17

Tuesday Jan 28th Commences with fine weather Wind
from the S.W. this part saw nothing Sundown wore
Ship and took in the main sail middle part fair
later part fresh breezes from the W.S.W. saw two
sail this part saw five backs Lat 43 22 Long 75 17

Wednesday Jan 29th Commences with fresh breezes from
the W.S.W. saw nothing but five backs and Sulphur bottom
Sundown double reef the top Sails blowing fresh
the morning light came down and left two miles
or of us 4 miles of the land 25 miles of middle part
later part 6 fog 2 lit up 2 made all sail
Wind S.W. saw two sail Lat 43 22 Long 75 12
